

Dog beds donated to care center

Red Bluff >> The Tehama County Animal Care Center has recently received a donation of more than 20 Kuranda dog beds, in addition to parts needed to repair 11 additional beds.

Volunteers from PETS, or Providing Essentials for Tehama Shelter, spent a whole day building the beds and repairing the old ones.

PETS noticed recently that many of the dog beds at the center were worn and needed repair. Thanks to donations from the public and members, every dog in the center now has a bed to sleep on. The total value of the bed donation was more than \$1,200.

“These beds make such a difference for the dogs here,” said manager Christine McClintock. “Having a cozy place to sleep reduces stress, sore joints and generally keeps the dogs healthy. In addition, the concrete can be quite cold in the wintertime, so the beds will help keep the dogs comfortable all year round.”
