

Animal care center in Tehama County is lowering fees for holiday adoption event

RED BLUFF, Calif. — On Thursday, the Tehama County Animal Care Center (TCACC) kicked off their fifth annual "Home for the Holidays" pet adoption event.

Those looking to adopt have until Saturday to take advantage of discounted fees and prices.

TCACC says every dog is \$25 and under and every cat four months or older is free. Kittens are \$10.

All animals are spayed/neutered and microchipped. During the winter months, TCACC says they see a spike in stray animals because of winter storms.

Harsh weather conditions can cause damage to encapsulating fences and the animal care center says some pets can become startled and run away during storms.

Christine McClintock, Manager, Tehama County Animal Care Center says she does not recommend putting your furry friend under the tree for Christmas but now is a great time to come down and pick one out as a family.

"What we find works best is when a family decides that they are going to get a pet for Christmas because that is what their kid wants this year and they bring the whole family down. Everybody gets to meet a couple of the dogs and find the dog that is the right personality, right activity style, just the best fit for their home," said
