

Free spay and neuter clinic coming to Tehama County

Tehama County Animal Care Center will be hosting a three-day spay/neuter clinic in Tehama County, courtesy of the Peninsula Humane Society and SPCA.

Peninsula Humane Society will offer free spay/neuter to pets of low-income Tehama County residents Oct. 26-28. The clinic will be in Corning on Friday, Oct. 26 and in Rancho Tehama on Monday, Oct. 28. Surgery spots will be available for both dogs and cat on these days. On Sunday, Oct. 27, the clinic will be in Los Molinos to spay/neuter cats only.

“We are very grateful to have Peninsula Humane Society come to Tehama County once again,” said manager Christine McClintock. “These free spay neuter clinics offer some of our residents the chance to improve their pets’ lives, some of whom might not have been able to afford spay/neuter services otherwise. We cannot say enough good things about Peninsula Humane Society, and the San Francisco Bay Humane Friends, who make this clinic possible.”

Peninsula Humane Society's free spay neuter clinic is funded entirely by donations made to the San Francisco Bay Humane Friends group.

There are up to 24 surgery spots available per day, but there are size restrictions and income qualifications that apply.

Interested persons must call or come into the Animal Care Center. Surgery spots will be available on a first come, first served basis to qualified surgical candidates.

The Tehama County Animal Care Center is at 1830 Walnut St. in Red Bluff. Care Center hours are 8 a.m. to noon and 1-5 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 10 a.m. to noon and 1-5 p.m. Saturday. Adoption hours are 10 a.m. to noon and 1-4:30 p.m.
