PETS is a non-profit dedicated to improving the welfare, and creating public awareness, of the abandoned, neglected or abused animals in Tehama County. It is a public forum for the shelter, providing pictures and information about pets at the shelter waiting for their families.

The group distributes spay and neuter certificates to the public and members are strongly committed to assist the Tehama County Animal Care Center in completing its mission of practicing and promoting responsible compassionate care to all animals, both in its care and in the community.

The purchase of a Paw Print will support the life-saving work of providing spay and neuter vouchers to the public; providing special adoption events and rescue opportunities for homeless dogs, cats and more; sponsorship of adoption programs for law enforcement and firefighters and seniors; subsidizing medical care to animals in need; purchasing equipment and supplies to provide comfort and improve the quality of life for animals at the center; being an active resource during times of disaster; providing transport for animals in and outside of California for adoptions, rescues and medical care; providing education and being a resource for the community.

PETS representatives will be at Nu-Way 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Friday, July 5, hosting a meet and greet with the public and offering free raffle tickets to anyone who comes up and says hello. Come meet some nice folks, get a flyer, view the basket and get your ticket.
